Assembly	Ease of Assembly	Medium. Not as straightforward as machines from other manufacturers but simple enough that most people are able to build these without any problems.
	No. of people required	2 people are required. One to hold some parts in position whilst the second person tightens the bolts.
	Time to assemble	30 – 40 minutes
	Clarity of Assembly Guide	Good – simple to follow.
Quality	Paintwork	Smooth finish to paintwork. High quality finish
	Plastics	Very good. Fit together well and all are moulded to the highest standard.
	Build Quality	Good. Feels sturdy and well built. This is a very imposing machine and is physically much taller than most other machines.
Usability	How easy is the machine to use	Simple. Buttons on the console are self explanatory. Easy to use, although does lack speed and incline buttons on the handrails.
	Clarity of Instruction Manual	Good.
	Running Deck	The best feature of this treadmill. Huge running deck that is well sprung and with an orthopedic running belt for additional cushioning. This is a great machine to run on – really comfortable.
	Controls	All controls are easily accessible and straightforward to use.
	Console and Feedback	The console is very big!! It is easy to use and has good levels of feedback (including a dot matrix display that shows where you are in the program). Also houses speakers.
Ownership	Maintenance Requirements	Belt adjustment and deck lubrication as with all treadmills. Hoover out motor cover occasionally.
	Storage	Not the easiest machine to move since it only has 2 transport wheels. Running deck folds up for storage.
	Length of Warranty	Excellent warranty – lifetime on the frame and motor and 3 years parts and labour.
	Manufacturer Service	Excellent – always responsive
