Assembly	Ease of Assembly	An easy machine to assemble. Lift the console mast and secure into position using the bolts provided and then do the same with the console. A few plastics to fit to finish and you're ready to go.
	No. of people required	Possible for one person to assemble, but much easier with two.
	Time to assemble	30 minutes
	Clarity of Assembly Guide	Could be better. It's not really clear which bolts secure the bottom of the console mast to the frame. Fortunately there are so few bolts it's easy to work out.
Quality	Paintwork	Excellent
	Plastics	Fit well and feel secure
	Build Quality	Feels like a substantial machine when assembled. No major issues.
Usability	How easy is the machine to use	Really straightforward
	Clarity of Instruction Manual	Could be better but it is possible to work out
	Running Deck	Perfectly adequate for anyone who is 5'9" or smaller
	Controls	All controls are on the console which can make increasing/decreasing speed/incline difficult when running. Other than that it's an easy to operate machine.
	Console and Feedback	Gives you all of the information that you need. The only drawback is that it doesn't show you where you are in your program.
Ownership	Maintenance Requirements	Make sure that the belt is adjusted correctly and that the deck is lubricated. Nothing too onerous.
	Storage	Folds for storage and is on wheels. Not too heavy so it's easy to store away.
	Length of Warranty	A good warranty is offered with this machine. 10 Years Motor and Frame, 2 Years Parts and Labour
	Manufacturer Service	The manufacturer is based in Spain with a network of engineers in the UK who visit your home if there is a warranty callout.
