Category	Review of...	Means
Assembly	Ease of Assembly	Simple. Console posts and console have a scissor action to fold up and bolt into place.
	No. of people required	Can be done by 1 person, but we recommend having a second person around because of the weight of the machine.
	Time to assemble	15 – 30 minutes
	Clarity of Assembly Guide	Good – simple to follow.
Quality	Paintwork	Textured finish to paintwork is extremely hard wearing.
	Plastics	Very good. Well moulded and easy to fit.
	Build Quality	Excellent – feels extremely sturdy
Usability	How easy is the machine to use	Very easy. The machine only has 6 programs (more than enough for most people) and so is easy to use.
	Clarity of Instruction Manual	No problems here – instruction manual is clear to follow and tells you what you need to know.
	Running Deck	As an entry level machine in this range it has a huge running deck compared to other similar models. If you want anything better then you'll need a treadmill with an orthopedic belt.
	Controls	All controls are easily accessible. If you want handrail controls for speed and incline then you'll need to look at the next model up in the range.
	Console and Feedback	Nice and simple. Everything that you need to know is shown.
Ownership	Maintenance Requirements	Belt adjustment and deck lubrication as with all treadmills. Make sure to Hoover out dust from the motors regularly (there is no backboard on the treadmill to guard against dust collecting in the motor housing.)
	Storage	Has 4 transport wheels so is easy to move. Running deck folds up for storage.
	Length of Warranty	Excellent warranty – 10 years motor and frame and 3 years parts and labour.
	Manufacturer Service	Excellent – always responsive
